FOR YOUR INFORMATION

The Golf Club at Haverhill is a very friendly meeting place, with an excellent clubhouse incorporating all modern facilities, stud bar, changing rooms, showers, bar and restaurant.

There is no discrimination between lady and gentlemen members. Subscriptions are the same and the course is available to all members at any time, providing there are no competitions taking place. No tee bookings required. We have a very healthy junior section where the younger players are helped and encouraged extensively.

All ladies, and men over 55 years, are invited to join the Senior Section, where you are guaranteed a playing partner nearly every weekday if you wish. Senior league matches take place throughout the year and there are many friendly inter-club confrontations.

Some of the social competitions are followed by an evening function, and as a rule, during the winter months quite a few social functions are arranged to take place, which do not include golf!

The main feature of the golf club is the course itself. Established in the mid seventies as a council course, it was taken over by members in the early eighties and has thrived since then. The 18-hole course lies across two valleys and is set in pleasant parkland. The front nine, with it's undulating fairways, is admirably complimented by a saucer shaped back nine, which is bisected by the River Stour as it meanders through a course with greens reputed to be among the best in the county. It certainly presents a challenge to both the seasoned golfer and newcomer alike.

On application, we ask for a £25 deposit, but this is deducted from your joining fee of £500. The subscriptions for the year 2010/11 are £550 for 5 days (Monday to Friday, excluding Bank Holidays) and £630 for seven days.

The Club uses the facilities of Fairway Credit, which is an easy payment scheme for golfers, where the yearly subscriptions can be spread over the playing year at 5.8% interest.

Our membership cards double up as debit cards, and after an initial payment of cash, which is loaded on to your card, most purchases made from the bar receive a discount, providing your card is used for payment. The bar person can top up your balance at any time.

If you like the sound of Haverhill Golf Club, complete your application form and send it in. The waiting list is not very long, as we are hoping to slowly expand our membership. A short informal interview with members of the committee takes place before you join, which allows them to apprise you of various club rules.
