<b>Malvasia Spumante Dolez Campana</b> <i>Tones of floral, aromatic fruit but lower alcohol at 7.5%. Delicious at any time but sublime with spicy food.</i>	(Italy)	£15.95
<b>Reggiano DOC Lambrusco Rosato il Portico</b> <i>Wow! Dry sparkling rosé as good as this usually costs a fortune. Looks brilliant, tastes amazing – what are you waiting for?</i>	(Italy)	£16.95

<b>Muscadet Sur les Domaines du Poirier</b> <i>Very dry but with such superb mouthfeel from the lees ageing that it actually feels fatter in the Mouth. Superb with fish.</i>	(France)	£15.95
<b>Pinot Grigio DOC Antigniano</b> <i>A wine that displays all the classic hallmarks of old-fashioned Pinot Grigio; depth, richness and spicy weight. Looks good too!</i>	(Italy)	£16.95
