



Greens Winter Newsletter



- ❖ Fairways will be verti-drained on **w/c 23rd JANUARY 2012**.
NB: While fairways are being worked on, relevant holes may be closed for play.
- ❖ Please treat temporary greens as GUR. Same rules apply.
- ❖ Greens are being cut by hand to a length of 6mm.
- ❖ Temporary Greens will be used in frosty and very wet conditions. If main greens are not fit to play on by 10.30 am then the temporary greens will remain in play all day.
- ❖ Ropes and white lines around the greens are to protect wet areas from extreme wear. Please walk around to protect the course.
- ❖ Buggy users should only drive in the rough and walk 90° to their ball to protect the fairways.
- ❖ Please be aware that Yellow blocks on tees may be moved forward to unused areas to ease wear.
- ❖ Mats will be used on 2nd, 13th, 15th & 17th Tees plus others as required.
- ❖ Please repair pitch marks as these areas of damaged turf are more prone to disease, which can ruin your playing surface and is expensive to rectify.
- ❖ Greens will continue to be verti-drained and slit in order to keep them playable as much as possible.
- ❖ Work will commence on 2nd left hand greenside bunker and 3rd right hand greenside bunker w/c 16th January. Treat these as GUR whilst remedial work is taking place.

NB: During very wet periods an electric trolley ban may be imposed at short notice
