The social golf and barbecue on May 31st was a huge success with over 40 people taking part and many others who came for the lovely barbecue provided by Tonya and her team.


The winners were Craig Dickson, George Dickson, Tom Peel and Glen Rossiter. 2nd place was Grahame Mizen, John

Well the April showers have come in May! 81mm of rain fell last month, which is 79mm more than May last year! So that said, growth has really picked up now with the warmer temperatures finally arriving and the course is starting to become a grass factory once again.

The greens have been lowered to 4mm and we are now cutting 6 out of the 7 days. Some days are being cut and rolled and we aim to verti-cut once a week too. The Poa grass on the greens is seeding at the moment which gives them the white tinge and is preventing them from being overly fast because of the added friction. The greens are quite soft with the amount rain so once again please remember to repair pitchmarks.

The putting green is starting to recover with the growth and hopefully it should all be back in play very soon.

The 4<sup>th</sup> apron is also recovering, however we are seeing that the crows have been doing some damage to it again. We shall have to continue to repair the damage they cause until a cure can be found to rid the leather jackets.

Many thanks to Brownie who continues to give up his time each week to cut the rough for us. The Snake (rough cutter) is proving to be a real benefit with it's speed and presentation it leaves the course. Let's all now hope we don't get a drought!
