Thank you for your enquiry regarding Visiting Swaffham Golf Club. Please find enclosed information regarding bookings. Please return a copy to the Club Office as soon as possible.

## The following requirement is most important:

Provisional bookings can be made on the telephone, letter or e-mail, however no guaranteed booking will be made until your booking form and a *non-refundable* deposit of £5 per player is received at the club. Your provisional booking will be held on a first come first booked basis only.

(Please note: Your deposit will be kept in credit if the course is closed due to adverse weather conditions or your visit is postponed for any reason)

<u>DISCOUNT RATES</u>: To qualify for the following discounted rates your group or society must be a minimum of 13 Players paying the group rate (ie: no Swaffham members) otherwise the normal green fee rates will apply, these rates cannot be used in conjunction with any other special green fee offers.

The cost of golf not including food varies dependent on day and time of visit

# ON THE COURSE OR CLUBHOUSE

"Appropriate" clothing to include;

Gentlemen: Proper golf shoes — No Trainers - Smart casual trousers - No Blue Denims or Cargo type trousers — No tracksuits or shell suits - Sports Shirts with collars & Sleeves which should be tucked in. No football/rugby style shirts with logos, team names or numbers - Tailored Shorts with long socks or sports socks — No trousers tucked into socks.

Ladies: Are asked to note the following variations.

Sleeveless blouses must have collars - Round necked/V necked blouses must have sleeves - Blouses designed to be worn outside trousers are permitted - Smart casual trousers No blue Jeans or cargo type trousers allowed

**IN THE CLUBHOUSE** - Members, their guests and visitors are asked to dress appropriately for any event they are attending, which will be advertised.

Acceptable: Golf Shoes can be worn to access the PSI machine.

Not Acceptable: Trainers, stocking feet, waterproofs, mens hats
